Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Survey 2026

A message from the RPC Chair

What is CIL and why are we asking you about it?

When developers build in our area, they pay a levy called the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) to East Suffolk Council. Because Reydon has a Neighbourhood Plan, our Parish Council receives 25% of all CIL money collected within the Parish. By law, we must spend it on infrastructure to support our growing community. This falls into three main areas:

- **Physical** – eg transport links, utilities, flood defences etc.
- **Social** – eg education, healthcare, emergency services and community or sports halls.
- **Green** – eg parks, woodlands, play areas and public open spaces.

Although some of our current CIL money is already committed to various projects, this survey will help us to understand what you see as important projects to pursue in the future. It should, however, be noted that the sums of money needed vary considerably, so some may be more feasible in the shorter term. The results of the survey will be shared at our Parish Council meeting in **October 2026** and you are very welcome to attend.
