Tues 28th Jan 4-6pm and 7-8.30pm

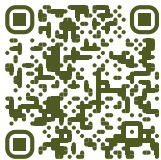
Drop-in session 4-6pm, followed by a second session starting with a presentation at 7pm, and followed by a Q&A session.
