DC/25/4554/FUL – Single storey rear extension replacing existing conservatory, 1 Fieldview Close, Reydon IP18 6PR. Response by 19<sup>th</sup> Feb 25.

DC/25/0313/FUL – Alterations to front porch, 3 Fieldview Close, Reydon IP18 6PR

Response by 27<sup>th</sup> Feb 25.
